## DEFINITIONS OF COLOR VOCABULARY

HUE

• ANOTHER TERM FOR COLOR

INTENSITY

- THE BRIGHTNESS OR DULLNESS OF A HUE
- CHANGED BY MIXING A COLOR WITH ITS COMPLEMENT
- Creates a tone of the original hue

VALUE

- THE AMOUNT OF BLACK AND WHITE IN A COLOR
- THE LIGHTNESS OR DARKNESS OF A HUE
- Changed by adding white or black to a color

TINTS

- CREATED BY ADDING WHITE TO HUE
- ALSO CALLED PASTELS
- Examples: Baby blue, peach, pink

SHADES

- ADDING BLACK TO A HUE
- Examples: Navy blue, forest green, burgundy
